I write today to thank you for the extremely generous offer from the management team at MaintSmart Software, Inc. This proposal was brought to my attention by an incoming volunteer, Phil Angell. We at Olancho Aid are very happy to welcome Phil as he will be helping to develop and implement strategies to better manage our facilities. We gratefully welcome this opportunity to use MaintSmart software to make this objective possible, especially considering the limited resources to which we have access.

The Olancho Aid Foundation oversees 4 schools that serve almost 900 students in Honduras, including 77 children with special needs at the *only* special needs school in the state of Olancho (about the size of Maryland). Education has always been the core of our work. After deeply realizing the connection between clean water and education, we have installed 24 water purification systems serving more than 5,000 families. Children who drink clean water are healthier, so they miss fewer days of school and are able to focus on their studies, instead of feeling ill.

Our schools began in the early 2000s and the growth was staggering. In the last few years, our focus has been to stabilize the operation so that we can sustainably serve our community for the long term as well as to have the infrastructure in place for potential future growth. MaintSmart Software will take us one big step closer to this goal.

Thank you again for offering the software to the Olancho Aid Foundation free of cost. I assure you that this contribution will have a lasting positive impact for our organization, and more importantly, for the children and community we serve here in Honduras.
